6.1.2.a. Decentralization, Participative Management, and Collective Decision Making

The decentralization, delegation of power, and collective decision-making are also enhanced through the involvement and participation of the faculty in the various committees. The list of the faculty members in the committees is detailed in the SFIMAR Activity and Event calendar prepared before the commencement of the academic year.

In addition, the delegation of power and decentralization in the institute flows from the Director to the Programme Heads, Departmental Heads, and all other heads of the committees.

Director

- 1. To be responsible for all the institute's operations as per directions from the Governing Council/Executive Committee, Chairman, and other statutory and regulatory bodies.
- 2. To give overall direction to all departments in academic matters.
- 3. To train and empower the subordinates to enhance/ upgrade their skills and competencies to achieve efficiency and effectiveness.
- 4. To play a pivotal role in building up the faculty as a cohesive and collaborative team.
- 5. To work out strategies to bring quality to every department of the institute, including the institute's website.
- 6. To ensure smooth functioning of college events and programs and ensuring 100 % attendance of students and staff.
- 7. To take proactive efforts for ensuring 100% final and summer placements of the students
- 8. To conduct regular faculty meetings, CDC meetings, Alumni Association meetings, and all other statutory meetings
- 9. To ensure faculty and student discipline.
- 10. To work for continuous up-gradation of the curriculum for meeting the industry requirements.

- 11. To conduct faculty appraisal at the end of every semester and submit it to the Executive Committee/Chairman.
- 12. To prepare and implement HR Policy Manual and Faculty Promotions Policy.
- 13. To take proactive efforts to promote MDPs, Consultancy, and Industry Interaction.
- 14. To make efforts to support business and industry through research endeavors and active involvement of students in live projects for ensuring successful completion of them on time.
- 15. To explore possibilities of active collaboration/linkages with reputed foreign universities
- 16. To motivate students to be value-based entrepreneurs.

Programme Head - MMS

A. Strategic Role:

- 1. Forecasting academic and administrative improvements, budgeting, and implementing any changes.
- 2. Strategic support for all existing initiatives and introducing new initiatives related to Academics and Administration.
- 3. Keeping updated on the latest news/notification from the University / AICTE / DTE in collaboration with Administration, disseminating the same to all concerned and implementing as required.

B. Operational / Supervisory Role:

Coordination of all the academic activities and overall monitoring of the same is appended below.

- 1. Planning and Preparation of Academic Calendar, Work Load, Time Table semester-wise in coordination with Academic Co-ordinator and Facilitators.
- 2. Monitoring of Session Plans for courses semester-wise.
- 3. Planning and scheduling the Roster for Guest Lectures/Workshops/Activities in consultation with Academic Co-ordinator and Facilitators.
- 4. Monitoring of visiting faculty in coordination with the Programme Associate.

C. Examination Controlling:

1. Issue exam notification two weeks in advance of the commencement of the semester examination.

- 2. Coordinate with faculty members to prepare two sets of Question Papers for each subject and arranging the photocopies of the selected Question Papers one day in advance of the respective subject exams.
- 3. Preparation of invigilation schedule and circulate it one week before the commencement of the exams (internal examinations)
- 4. Identify rooms for conducting the exam and making appropriate seating arrangements as per the seating plan.
- 5. Ensuring that the exams are conducted as per the schedule and as per the examination procedure.
- 6. Communicating the time frame available for paper correction and submission of marks.
- 7. Preparation of results in consultation with the Director and identifying the failures.
- 8. Conducting the supplementary examinations for the students who have failed.
- 9. Notifying the final results of the MMS-I, Semester I & II only.
- 10. Preparation of mark sheets of MMS-I, Semester I & II only.
- 11. For semesters III & IV, the marks after the respective examination are compiled, checked, and forwarded to the University on or before the due date notified by the University.
- 12. Reporting to Director/Chairman.

The Programme Head, Academic Co-ordinator, and the Facilitators, Mentors, and Faculty members ensure that all the activities required for the attainment of the Programme are well-taken care of. Their collective involvement fortifies the teaching-learning process and enhances the employability of the students.

Financial Powers

A reimbursement policy is in place. Advance cash encashment and settling of accounts are direct with the Institute's Accountant by the event coordinators, and Departmental Heads are in practice. Besides, the institute is introducing a ceiling system during the financial year wherein the Departmental Heads and Director will have financial accessibility devoid of financial approval subject to proper settling of the accounts with the Institute Accountant.

Those who can multi-task, take initiative, and are enterprising have better chances of getting hired. Students grow in multiple directions if they actively participate in college fests. Students who volunteer and

organize college fests display their self-starter attitude, which is highly appreciated by recruiters, especially while hiring for managerial positions. Besides that, students also develop four essential skills from organizing fests – planning, teamwork, leadership, and multi-tasking. They also learn how to balance personal and professional life which helps in differentiating between doers and dreamers.
